Section 1;

Scripture confirming, "New Months", are weekly seasonal Sabbaths according to the Sacrificial Law Calendar. (With reference to Numbers 10:10, 28:9, 10 and 11) Please review the 12 scriptures below which confirm to this fact!

Numbers 10:10; Also in the day of your gladness, and in your appointed times, and in the *beginnings of your months*, ye shall *blow with the trumpets* over your burnt offerings, and over the sacrifices of your peace offerings; that they may be to you for a memorial before your God: I [am] the LORD your God.

Numbers 28:9; And on the sabbath day two lambs of the first year without spot, and two tenth deals of flour [for] a meat offering, mingled with oil, and the drink offering thereof: 10; [This is] the burnt offering of *every sabbath*, beside the continual burnt offering, and his drink offering. 11; And in the *beginnings of your months* ye shall offer a burnt offering unto the LORD; two young bullocks, and one ram, seven lambs of the first year without spot;

- 1. Psalms 81:3; *Blow up the trumpet in new months in the appointed day, our solemn feast day*.
- 2. 1 Chronicles 23:31; And to all burnt sacrifices unto the LORD to sabbaths, to new months, and to set feasts in number, according to the order commanded unto them, continually before the LORD:
- 3. 2 Chronicles 31:3; and assign the king's portion from his substance for the burnt offerings, for the morning and evening burnt offerings, and the burnt offerings for sabbaths and for new months, and for appointed feasts, as [it is] written in the law of the LORD.
- 4. 2 Chronicles 2:4; Behold, I build an house to the name of the LORD my God, to dedicate [it] to him, [and] to burn before him sweet incense, and for the continual shewbread, and for the burnt offerings morning and evening, on sabbaths and to new months, and to appointed feasts of the LORD our God perpetual, on Israel.
- 5. 2 Chronicles 8:13; Even after a certain rate every day, offering according to the commandment of Moses, on the sabbaths, and on the new months, and on the solemn feasts, three times in the year, [even] in the feast of unleavened bread, and in the feast of weeks, and in the feast of tabernacles.
- 6. Nehemiah 10:33; For the arranged shewbread, and for continual meat offering, and for continual burnt offering the sabbaths the new months, for appointed feasts, and for holiness and for sin offerings to make an atonement for Israel, and all for the work of the house of our God.
- 7. Ezra 3:5; And afterward [offered] the continual burnt offering, both of the new months, and of all the set feasts of the LORD that were consecrated, and of every one that willingly offered a freewill offering unto the LORD.
- 8. Isaiah 66:23; And it shall come to pass, [that] from one new month to another and from one sabbath to another, shall all flesh come to worship before me, saith the LORD.

(Note; here it clearly states that we are to worship on new months, which are weekly Sabbaths, which must line up on the same day!)

9. Ezekiel 46:1; Thus saith the Lord GOD; The gate of the inner court that looketh toward the east shall be shut the six working days; but on the sabbath it shall be opened, and in the day of the new months it shall be opened.

(Note; the gates are open for worship only on new months, and Sabbaths day. There again Sabbaths and New Months must line up on the same day!)

10. Ezekiel 46:3; Likewise the people of the land shall worship at the door of this gate before the LORD in sabbaths and in new months. v4; And the burnt offering that the prince shall offer unto the LORD in the sabbath day [shall be] six lambs without blemish, and a ram without blemish. v5; And the meat offering [shall be] an ephah for a ram, and the meat offering for the lambs as he shall be able to give, and an hin of oil to an ephah. v6; And in the day of the new month [it shall be] a young bullock without blemish, and six lambs, and a ram: they shall be without blemish.

(Note; this scripture take us back to Numbers 28; 9, 10 and 11 that new [seasonal] months are important Sabbaths day to God.

- 11. Hosea 2:11; I will also cause all her delight to cease, her feast days, her new months, and her sabbaths, and all her solemn feasts.
- 12. Colossians 2:16; Let no man therefore judge you in meat, or in drink, or in respect of an holyday, or of the new months, or of the sabbath [days]:

Section 2;

Scripture confirming, "first, fourth, seventh, and tenth months" are the first day of the "New Seasonal Month".

- 1. Genesis 8:5; And the waters decreased continually until the tenth month: in the <u>tenth [month]</u>, on the <u>first [day] of the month</u>, were the tops of the mountains seen.
- 2. Genesis 8:13; And it came to pass in the six hundredth and first year, in the <u>first [month]</u>, the <u>first [day] of the month</u>, the waters were dried up from off the earth: and Noah removed the covering of the ark, and looked, and, behold, the face of the ground was dry.
- 3. Exodus 40:17; And it came to pass in the <u>first month in the second year</u>, on the <u>first [day] of the</u> <u>month</u>, the tabernacle was reared up.
- 4. Ezra 3:6; From the <u>first day</u> of the <u>seventh month</u> began they to offer burnt offerings unto the LORD. But the foundation of the temple of the LORD was not [yet] laid.
- 5. Ezra 10:16; And the children of the captivity did so. And Ezra the priest, [with] certain chief of the fathers, after the house of their fathers, and all of them by [their] names, were separated, and sat down in the <u>first day</u> of the <u>tenth month</u> to examine the matter. Ezra 10:17; And they made an end with all the men that had taken strange wives by the <u>first day</u> of the <u>first month</u>.
- 6. Nehemiah 8:2; And Ezra the priest brought the law before the congregation both of men and women, and all that could hear with understanding, upon the <u>first day</u> of the <u>seventh month</u>.

- 7. Ezekiel 29:17; And it came to pass in the seven and twentieth year, in the <u>first [month]</u>, in the <u>first [day] of the month</u>, the word of the LORD came unto me, saying,
- 8. 2 Chronicles 29:17; Now they began on the <u>first [day] of the first month</u> to sanctify, and on the <u>eighth day of the month</u> came they to the porch of the LORD: so they sanctified the house of the LORD in eight days; and in the sixteenth day of the first month they made an end.
- 9. Jubilees' 3:28; and at the <u>new month</u> of the <u>fourth month</u> Adam and his wife came out of the Garden of Eden and dwelt in the land of Elda, in the land of their creation.
- 10. Jubilees' 5:27; and in the fourth month the fountains of the great deep were closed, and the flood-gates of heaven were restrained, and in the <u>new month</u> of the <u>seventh month</u> all the mouths of the deep of the earth were opened, and the water began to descend into the deep below. v28; and in the <u>new month</u> of the <u>tenth month</u> the tops of the' mountains became visible, and in the <u>new month</u> of the <u>first month</u> the earth became visible.
- 11. Jubilees' 6:1; And at the <u>new month</u> of the <u>third month</u> he came out of the ark and built an altar on that hill.
- 12. Jubilees' 14:1; And after these events, in the fourth year who this week, in the <u>new month</u> of the <u>third month</u>, the voice of the Lord came to Abram in a dream, saying: "Fear not, Abram, for I am thy defender and thy exceeding great reward.
- 13. Jubilees' 16:1; And at the <u>new month</u> of the <u>fourth month</u> we appeared to Abraham at the oak of Mamre, and we conversed with him, and we announced to him that a son would be given him from Sarah his wife.

Section 3;

Scripture confirming, "Sabbaths", that line up with the biblical calendar.

- Jubilees' 5:29; and the waters disappeared from above the earth in the <u>fifth week</u>, in the <u>seventh year</u> thereof, and on the <u>seventeenth day</u> in the <u>second month</u> the earth became dry.
 30; and on the <u>twenty-seventh</u> thereof he opened the ark and sent out of it the animals and the beasts and the birds and whatever moves.
- 1 Maccabees 4:52; Now on the <u>five and twentieth day of the ninth month</u>, which is called the <u>month Casleu</u>, in the hundred forty and eighth year, they rose up betimes in the morning, v53; And offered sacrifice according to the law upon the new altar of burnt offerings, which they had made.
- 3. 1 Maccabees 14:27; So then they wrote it in tables of brass, which they set upon pillars in mount Sion: and this is the copy of the writing; The <u>eighteenth day of the month Elul</u>, [sixth month] in the hundred threescore and twelfth year, being the third year of Simon the high priest,
- Jeremiah 52:3; And it came to pass in the seven and thirtieth year of the captivity of Jehoiachin king of Judah, in the <u>twelfth month</u>, in the <u>five</u> and <u>twentieth [day] of the month</u>, [that]
 Evilmerodach king of Babylon in the [first] year of his reign lifted up the head of Jehoiachin king of Judah, and brought him forth out of prison,

- 5. Nehemiah 6:15; So the wall was finished in the <u>twenty and fifth [day] of [the month] Elul</u>, in fifty and two days.
- 6. Zechariah 7:1; And it came to pass in the fourth year of king Darius, [that] the word of the LORD came unto Zechariah in the <u>fourth [day]</u> of the <u>ninth month</u>, [even] in Chisleu;
